# ARTISTS IN RESIDENCE

## ARTISTS

(e.g. painting, sculpture, photography, digital imaging, or video)

### SAMPLE PROGRAM:

- In-residence nine months including a week-long Intensive Study Workshop (required).
- Completion of up to six credits in arts-related coursework (included in program costs).
- Attendance at three visiting artist lectures or demonstrations.
- Three progress meetings/discussions per quarter with the Program Director.
- Completion of a new body of work of which one-two pieces may be selected for exhibit in culminating exhibition.

### ARTISTS ACCEPTANCE CRITERIA AND APPLICATION PROCESS

- Participants typically will already have obtained a BA or BFA.
- Applicants must submit a personal statement addressing their artistic vision, inspiration and goals.
- An electronic portfolio of 10 – 15 of their most recent creative work is also required and must include a list of the works with title, medium, size and date of completion. The portfolio will be reviewed by a panel of artists.
- Participants will be interviewed by the Program Director.
- GRE scores are not required.

## CURATORS

### SAMPLE PROGRAM:

- In-residence 12 months including completion of a week-long Intensive Study Workshop (required).
- Completion of up to six credits in arts-related coursework that must include an Art History course (included in program costs).
- Work with the Director of the University Art Galleries to develop a proposal for the culminating exhibition; select works; arrange loans; design exhibition; create exhibition catalogue; and, oversee installation and removal of exhibition.
- Attendance at three visiting artist lectures/demonstrations.
- Three progress meetings/discussions per quarter with the Program Director.

### CURATORS ACCEPTANCE CRITERIA AND APPLICATION PROCESS

- Participants typically will already have obtained a BA or BFA.
- Applicants must submit a letter of intent and a writing sample.
- Participants will be interviewed by the Program Director and the Director of the University Art Galleries.
- GRE scores are not required.



## PROGRAM FEES

Cost of the program is \$12,500. Payment plans are available. Fee includes up to two courses through University Extension; on-campus parking for the duration of the program; and use of a personal studio for those in the Artist's Track. Fee does not include materials.

There is an \$80 non-refundable application fee for all. Once accepted into the program, a \$1,000 non-refundable deposit is required to reserve admission space. The deposit will be applied to program costs. Applicant must read, agree to, and sign waivers and contract in order to participate in the program.
