A pianist will be provided.

Please have your music copied, in a binder, and in the correct key.

DANCE – Bring Tap and Jazz Shoes.

BRING – Picture & Resume in 8x10 format

WEAR – Audition attire.

Everyone will SING first: then be released to change for the dance call.

Program Dates: In New York City - March 23rd to April 21st, 2016 In Irvine - April 26th to June 2nd, 2016

The New York Satellite Program immerses you in the Broadway world of Musical Theatre. You work with Broadway choreographers, directors, actors, casting directors and agents. The daily class schedule is from 9 to 6pm for four weeks.

Classes include: voice coaching, monologue workshops, all styles of dance, casting workshops, enjoy Broadway shows and have talkbacks with Broadway directors, choreographers and actors as well as numerous theatre master classes. You are also required to audition while in New York and attend dance class at Steps and Broadway Dance.

Finally, each actor will be cast in an original 15-minute musical production called UCI's 4@15 New Musicals. You rehearse in New York with performances in both Manhattan and Irvine.

This intensive month-long program requires your full commitment. You will receive at least 16 hours of credit in the Spring Quarter for the NYSP program. If you have any questions, please contact me at mldelane@uci.edu.

To audition Drama majors MUST have completed Drama 30 A, B, and C. Senior Drama majors must have completed 40C to graduate in Spring 2015.
