- *MFA Master's Thesis:* All students must complete a thesis in English of approximately fifty pages on a topic approved by their graduate advisor, with appropriate bibliography, and with illustrative appendices, if warranted (e.g. musical examples, musical transcriptions, documents). All students must present the results of their research in a formal oral defense of 30 minutes before their committee and the entire Musicology faculty; after the presentation, they should be prepared to field questions from committee members and other Musicology faculty. Completion of thesis and oral defense take place during the six quarter of residence, no later than Week 8.
