Digital Filmmaking: Students will learn the proper operation and use of digital filmmaking equipment, including video recorders, monitors, cameras, audio-visual equipment, computer-based digital editing equipment, sound and lighting equipment and general use of the video facility. Through instruction, training and demonstration of digital filmmaking hardware and software, students will develop and create a media project. 


