The **Creative Connections** program provides a year-long teaching artist internship to UCI arts majors, preparing them to develop and implement arts-based curriculum and projects for K-12 students in collaboration with an Orange County area educator.

POSITION SUMMARY

A Teaching Artist Intern is a dedicated, enthusiastic individual who would like to gain valuable teaching experience and give back to their community. Interns are matched with an Orange County educator to augment the amazing work already being done in their classrooms. Interns will model and coach K-12 students through arts-based lessons and/or projects within their arts discipline. Interns will receive training to prepare and develop appropriate curriculum that values equity, diversity, inclusion, and youth safety.

- Attend and engage in all required staff activities, including trainings and meetings.
- Effectively communicate with matched Educator, Mentor and program staff on triumphs, challenges, and/or issues and concerns.
- Demonstrate ability to work independently and with little supervision, as well as work in a team setting.
- Serve as a positive role model.
- Foster and prioritize a safe and positive learning environment at all times.
