



**M.F.A. DRAMA – STAGE MANAGEMENT  
2020-2021 Degree Requirements**

- Drama 254:** Stage Management (7 courses) \_\_\_\_\_ 28 units
- Drama 240:** Graduate Projects (7 courses) \_\_\_\_\_ units vary
- Drama 251A-C:** Foundations of Theatre (3 courses) \_\_\_\_\_ 12 units
- Three elective courses in graduate-level (Drama 200+) or upper-division (Drama 100-199) course work**, as approved by the faculty advisor \_\_\_\_\_ units vary
- Two courses in Production Techniques**, chosen from **Drama 150-159, 162-164, 167-168, 170-171, 260A-262, 265-266** \_\_\_\_\_ 8 units

A total of 112 quarter units in graduate (200+) or approved upper-division undergraduate (100-199) courses must be completed with a grade of at least "B" in each course.

Normally three years of residence is required. Each candidate must enroll for three courses each quarter for nine quarters, exclusive of summer sessions.

During the first year of residence each candidate will prepare, for credit, two graduate projects, in acting, directing, design, music direction, stage management, theatrical research, or a combination of two of these. Satisfactory completion of these projects, as determined by the faculty, is prerequisite to entering the second year of the program.
