Continue to Communicate with UCI Admissions

- Continue to check your Admitted Student Portal page via <u>https://apply.admissions.uci.edu/manage/login?realm=&r=/portal/appli</u> <u>cantstatus</u> for:
 - Any message from UCI Admissions
 - Updates on your status
 - Transcript requests
 - AP/IB/SAT/ACT scores
- Remember to check/use your UCI Email account starting now!



Submitting Transcripts

- Transcripts are due by *July 1st* and test scores are due by *July 15th* to the Office of Admissions & Relations
- Admissions will place a hold on enrollment if transcripts/test scores are late
- Summer transcripts due **September 15**th

The sooner we get transcripts, the better we can assist with academic planning.

• Submit your **partial or full UC IGETC** certification to the Arts Student Affairs office

- Do not assume that all electronic transcripts will have your IGETC listed you will need to check with your community college with how they verify that you've completed UC IGETC
 - Certificates will not be accepted must list courses
- Submit by **fall quarter**; late submissions will impact courses you can enroll in (i.e. eligibility to enroll in upper division writing)



Paying Fees

Fee deadline Sept. 15th by 5 PM

E-Billing System – paperless tuition bill

- Check your tuition and fees
 - ZOT Account Online
 - <u>WebReg</u>
 - <u>StudentAccess</u>
- Classes are dropped if a student's tuition and fees are not paid by 5 p.m. on the fee payment deadline.
 - If your courses are dropped, it is not guaranteed that you can get back into them.
