#### **REQUIREMENTS:**

SING - One 16 Bar up-tempo or ballad (no rock or pop songs)
A pianist will be provided.
Sign-up for a group time on the Drama Callboard.

DANCE – Bring Character or Jazz Shoes. BRING – Picture & Resume in 8x10 format WEAR – Audition attire.

Please have your music copied w/ taped corners, in a binder back to front, and in the key right for you.

Everyone will SING first: a short dance audition will follow.

#### **Program Dates for 2019:**

In New York City – Wednesday, March  $25^{th}$  (move-in) to Thursday, April  $23^{rd}$  (move-out date) In Irvine – Tuesday, April  $28^{th}$  to Thursday, June  $4^{th}$ 

### This intensive is open to all majors.

The New York Satellite Program immerses you in the Broadway world of Musical Theatre. You work with Broadway choreographers, directors, actors, casting directors and agents. The daily class schedule is from 9 to 6pm for four weeks.

Classes include: voice coaching, monologue workshops, all styles of dance, casting workshops, enjoy Broadway shows and have talkbacks with Broadway directors, choreographers and actors as well as numerous theatre master classes with professional actors in the city. You are also required to audition while in New York and attend dance classes in New York dance studios.

This intensive month-long program requires your full commitment. You will receive at least 16 hours of credit in the Spring Quarter for the NYSP program. If you have any questions, please contact me at mldelane@uci.edu.

To audition Drama majors MUST have completed Drama 30 A, B, and C. Senior Drama majors must have completed 40C to graduate in Spring 2019.

Musical Theatre History – one quarter
Ballet – two quarters
Tap – one quarters

# THE NEW YORK SATELLITE PROGRAM IN MUSICAL THEATRE 2019 EXPENSES

The following numbers are a reference for you and your family to consider when planning for this program.

Program Fee \$ 2900

(This fee covers student housing in Manhattan, all classes, rehearsals, private instructor sessions and two group shows. This does NOT cover transportation, food, additional theatre tickets or extra classes.)

In addition, the following amounts should serve as a guide to other expenses you will incur:

Transportation	\$ 500
Food	500
Theatre	500
Personal spending	500

(These costs will vary per student spending habits.)

A deposit of \$1500.00 is due Monday, November 18<sup>th</sup>, to reserve the Manhattan housing. The Cashier's or Bank Check should be addressed to UCREGENTS. This deposit is non-refundable.

Obtaining housing in Manhattan is often difficult. We have been fortunate to have midtown apartments with easy access to the studios where class is held. Hopefully these accommodations will again be available in 2019. You will live two to four people in an apartment.

We will have THREE meetings during FALL Quarter as well as online assignments. (The dates and times TBD.) Each accepted member of NYSP 2019 will receive 16 units of academic credit for the program.
