

Graduation Checklist Information Session



Walking vs. Degree Completion

- Walking refers to participating in Commencement
- Degree Completion means you have met ALL requirements to complete your degree(s)





Eligibility

Students who will earn a degree during the 20-21 academic year – Fall '20, Winter '21, Spring '21 (or who expect to complete their degree requirements during Summer '21) – are eligible and welcome to participate in Commencement ceremonies.

Steps to Confirm Eligibility



- 1. Review your degree audit on **DegreeWorks** via **StudentAccess** to see any degree requirements you may have left to complete.
- Your DegreeWorks audit must show as complete in each section: University,
 General Education, and Major Requirements.
- 3. Your overall UCI GPA, major GPA, and upper-division GPA must ALL be a 2.0 or higher.

Confirm Graduation Eligibility with an Academic Advisor



- Total of 180 units
- All major requirements must be taken for a letter grade (no P/NP)

Commencement Program

- Review your Application for Graduation in StudentAccess to confirm that your name and major are both correct.
 - If your name is incorrect, you must <u>Request a Change of Name on UCI Records</u>.
 - If your major is incorrect, you must request a change through your academic advisor.
- If you have a written request with the Registrar's Office to restrict your public information (FERPA block), your name and major will not be included in the Commencement Program.

Commencement Registration **Subject to Change



- REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED to participate in the **University-wide virtual ceremony and virtual school receptions.**
- It is very important that graduates register before registration closes. Late registrations will not be accepted.
- Each school has a specific date and time assigned for them to BEGIN registration.



Academic Regalia; Caps, Gowns, and Tassels

- Purchase your cap and gown and other items through the UCI Alumni Association.
- There will be designated grad days to order and pick up.
- Sashes and stoles: UCI graduation sashes and stoles representing UCI organizations or proclaiming a vocational aspiration may be worn with a cap and gown.
 - Wearing multiple stoles is permitted.
 - These items can be purchased through the Hill.



Latin Honors



- General criteria;
 - completed at least 72 units in residence at a University of California campus and
 - cumulative GPA of 3.5 or better, including the grades from the final quarter.



Senior Photos

Check your emails for more information about your senior photos,
 this is not through our department.





- Students are issued one diploma for each degree awarded.
 - Majors completed at the same time in the same school are included on a single diploma.
 - Majors completed in different schools are issued separate diplomas.
- Minors and specializations are NOT included on the diploma but are posted on academic transcripts.

Honors Designations on Diploma

- Latin Honors and Campuswide Honors are posted on both the diploma and academic transcripts.
- University Honors designates students who have successfully completed BOTH
 the Campuswide Honors Collegium requirements and a school or major honors
 program. University Honors are not included on diplomas but are posted to
 academic transcripts.



Diploma Availability



- Diplomas are generally available:
 - Early July for winter degrees
 - Mid-October for spring degrees
 - Mid-January for summer degrees
 - Mid-April for fall degrees.





Diploma Pick-Up

 You may pick up your diploma at the Registrar's Office or request to have it sent to you by mail.

Transcripts

- Transcripts that include degree information will be available as follows:
 - Early May for degrees awarded in Winter Quarter
 - Early August for degrees awarded in Spring Quarter
 - Early November for degrees awarded in Summer Session
 - Early February for degrees awarded in Fall Quarter
