Happy week 7! Again, thank you for continued efforts to stay healthy and safe, and to keep our Music community healthy and safe as well. This is a friendly reminder that while the State of California is lifting its mandate for fully vaccinated persons to mask indoors beginning February 16th, which will require indoor masking only for unvaccinated individuals, as well as universal masking (both vaccinated and unvaccinated) only in specified settings outlined in the guidance, UCI's executive directive on face coverings will continue to remain in place. This means that universal masking is required in all indoor settings while on UCI property, for all students, staff, faculty and visitors.

## You're Invited! UCI Illuminations presents: Mariachi in the American Context

Title: "Mariachi in the American Context: From Mexico's Golden Age to a New American Genre"

Date: Sunday, Feb. 20, 2022

Through a lecture-recital, Luis Zambrano and his mariachi ensemble, Mariachi Nuevo Amanecer, will examine the transnational journey of mariachi music by performing and discussing popular mariachi repertoire. We will explore both the form and structure of the repertoire and understand the popularity and prevalence of mariachi music in contemporary America. The recital will discuss the Ranchera, a popular genre in Mariachi music, and explain why the early 20th century Rancheras, remain popular in contemporary American settings. The lecture aims to provide insight into mariachi music and attempt to inform audiences about the importance and cultural significance amongst a portion of the U.S. population. No preexisting knowledge of music is required. An English translation of the songs discussed will be provided to audiences.
